Respect for Life week will be January 23- 29th.

Friday the 28th of January is "Black Friday", the day that Canada lost all protection for the unborn. In 1988, a Supreme Court decision was made to remove abortion from the Criminal Code, allowing babies to be aborted at any time until birth. The unborn now have no legal status, and are not considered a person until they are born.
